Codicil

Please note

Please make sure that you sign the form in the presence of two adult witnesses who are **not** beneficiaries, or married to / in a civil partnership with a beneficiary, or Executor/Trustee. You and the witnesses must all be present together when you sign the Codicil and you must be present when each of the witnesses signs the Codicil.

We always recommend that you consult your solicitor to ensure that the Codicil ties in with your Will and to avoid any errors especially if you have a previous Codicil.

Once completed the Codicil should be kept with your current Will, but not attached to it.
