Roy went on to join the Navy and served for 10 years. Though they were not a couple when he signed up, the pair were smitten with one another, and they looked forward to seeing each other when Roy returned home on leave. They eventually got together and married, and went on to have two children.

Their son Greg said: "It's quite a story that my parents have known each other since Dad was six and Mum was only one, and it's lovely that they are able to still be together at Royal Star & Garter celebrating their 60th wedding anniversary. I'm grateful that staff made it such a special day for them, and we later had a wonderful afternoon celebrating their anniversary."
