They picked up the award at the GSF annual conference and awards ceremony at BMA House, London, which celebrated the UK's exceptional health and social care providers for care in the final year of life.

Reggie Ballos, Home Manager at Royal Star & Garter, later said: "It's really important to get end-of-life care right, because for each resident and their family, we only get the chance once. I'm so pleased that the dedication and love we put into our end-of-life care have been recognised with the GSF award."
