Please do let us know if Royal Star & Garter has been remembered in a Will. We understand that it may be some time before you are in a position to fulfil the bequest, however knowing about this kind gift does help us to plan for the future.

- A copy of the Will (or the extract that mentions the gift).

## Gifts of residue

Where Royal Star & Garter receives a share of the estate, we would appreciate being kept informed about the marketing and sale of any property in the estate, sale of investments, and any potential claims or delays to the administration.

Charities are exempt from many taxes, such as Inheritance Tax and Capital Gains Tax. In some cases, it may be helpful to appropriate Royal Star & Garter's share of assets directly to the charity pre-sale, in order to utilise the tax exemption. There are also special rules for the division of any Inheritance Tax liability between exempt charities and other beneficiaries.

Sometimes we may have to ask you for some additional information, as the charity is subject to strict legislation and we must comply with this when receiving gifts from estates. We are always happy to answer any questions you may have.
