The Solihull Home's open days take place on Thursday 3 April and Tuesday 8 April, from 11am to 1pm. In High Wycombe, they will be held on Tuesday 1 April and Thursday 10 April from 2-4pm.

They will be offered a tour of the Homes, which will include the in-house physiotherapy rooms and hair salons, gardens, activities rooms and lounges. Visitors will also have the chance to join in with the planned activities, and chat to the residents.
